## Daylight Newsletter November 2019

In February, we mentioned Peter who had come along to one of our Bible study groups. He was a lapsed catholic and had been disillusioned by things he had heard about wrongdoing in the church but had a lot of good, searching questions. We had been able to spend a session answering these, covering a lot of Gospel and Biblical issues and felt Peter seemed very close to faith. A couple of months later we were able to share that Peter had made a profession of faith and that there had been a dramatic change in him.

Since then, we have been encouraged to see Peter growing as he continues to attend the weekly Bible studies. As he is in an open prison, Peter goes out to do construction work, travelling a fair distance each day. He has a 5:30am start and comes straight to the Bible study after getting back. We recently commented to him that it was good of him to come and he said, "No. I love it! I don't want to miss it." Please pray that he will continue to grow in grace and that he will be a witness to others in the prison.

In another prison, one of our volunteer chaplains was recently speaking to James who was converted in prison. He had been at the service one of our teams had been running the previous Sunday and was very keen to tell our chaplain about the message he had heard. He said that he had been really helped by the sermon on the Bread of Life and that he had been reading the passage since the Sunday. It was wonderful to see him clearly rejoicing in the message, almost a week afterwards. Please pray that the services will continue to be an encouragement to James and that he will be helped as he studies God's Word for himself.

**HMP Cardiff (South Wales)** – We are halfway through a Christianity Explored course here, with several of the men attending having done the course before. Please pray that the Lord will bring Gospel light where there is currently sinful confusion.

**EFCC Conference** – Please pray for John as he takes a Daylight stand to the Evangelical Fellowship of Churches Ministers' Prayer Conference from 4th to 7th November. Pray that this will enthuse ministers about Daylight, prison opportunities and the vital importance of praying for those who work or reside in prisons.

**HMP Leeds (West Yorkshire)** – Give thanks that we have been able to start running monthly Bible studies here. Seven men attended in October and were keen to participate. Please pray that they and others will come along to the next session on 11th November.

**Murdo** – Over the last few years, many of our supporters have been praying for Murdo (Bury St Edmunds Prayer & Support Group) as he received treatment for pancreatic cancer.

Having returned to his home in the Hebrides to begin palliative care, Murdo went to be with the Lord on 17th October. His family shared the news with these words from Psalm 107 verses 29 & 30, "He maketh the storm a calm, so that the waves thereof are still. Then are they glad because they be quiet; so He bringeth them unto their desired haven."

Please continue to pray for the whole family at this time, but particularly for his wife Michelle.
